## Food Safety Certificate in Achievement

Graduates will demonstrate knowledge and skills required within the hospitality industry by national and local regulatory authorities. Upon successfully completing both units, graduates receive the Achievement in Food Safety.

## Entry Requirements

There is no entry criteria for this programme. Entry to the programme will be in order of receipt of enrolment.

## Skills you will learn

- The ability to understand and comply with health and safety legislation, and practise food safety methods to maintain a safe working environment.
- Knowledge of storage and temperature control of food, effective cleaning routines, and food contamination hazards and the methods used to control them.

Students must achieve both units to be awarded the Food Safety Certificate of Achievement.

#### CFS2.001 (NZQA Unit 167)
